4. Woody learns the Green River goes through Mammoth Cave Park. Research Mammoth Cave. Are there other lakes or rivers within Mammoth Cave Park?
5. Open the atlas to Kentucky and locate Mammoth Cave Park. What county is the park located?
6. While you are looking at the map of Kentucky, follow along with Woody and locate the rivers he discusses. Make sure to add them in the list you are keeping.
