


Dog Paddling Across the Bluegrass

WOODY'S MAZE

STARTING AT THE BLUE ARROW, FOLLOW THE
MAZE AND HELP WOODY FIND THE KEYS TO THE
BARGE.



1. Woody tells Jack he was born to dig and could dig for badgers if Jack needed him to. Why are badgers significant to dachshunds? Research to find out.
2. Jack tells Woody their barge is hauling coal from West Virginia to New Orleans. Although Jack doesn't say what town in West Virginia, let's say it's Charleston. If a truck is hauling coal from Charleston, West Virginia to New Orleans, Louisiana, how many miles one way would the truck have to drive? If the truck is driving 60 miles an hour, how many hours would it take the truck to make the trip?
3. Woody learned the crew consisted of the captain, pilot, several deckhands, and the cook. If you were going to work on the barge, what job would you prefer? Why?
4. Open the local newspaper and see if you can find any news story about a barge.
5. Using the internet, research to see if there are any barge companies in Kentucky. If so, where are they located? What do they haul? If they are in your area, maybe someone would come to your class and talk about what it's like to work on a barge.

TAKE A LOOK AT THAT!

As a class, go to *Google Images* and look up any items or places you've never seen before.
